

Mac OS X Dial Up connection How-to

How to set up a new NCN dial up connection.

On the Dock, click on the Finder icon.
Click on the Applications icon at the top.





Identify the Internet Connect icon and drag it to the dock. It will create a shortcut there. Click on the Finder icon on the dock again and open Network.

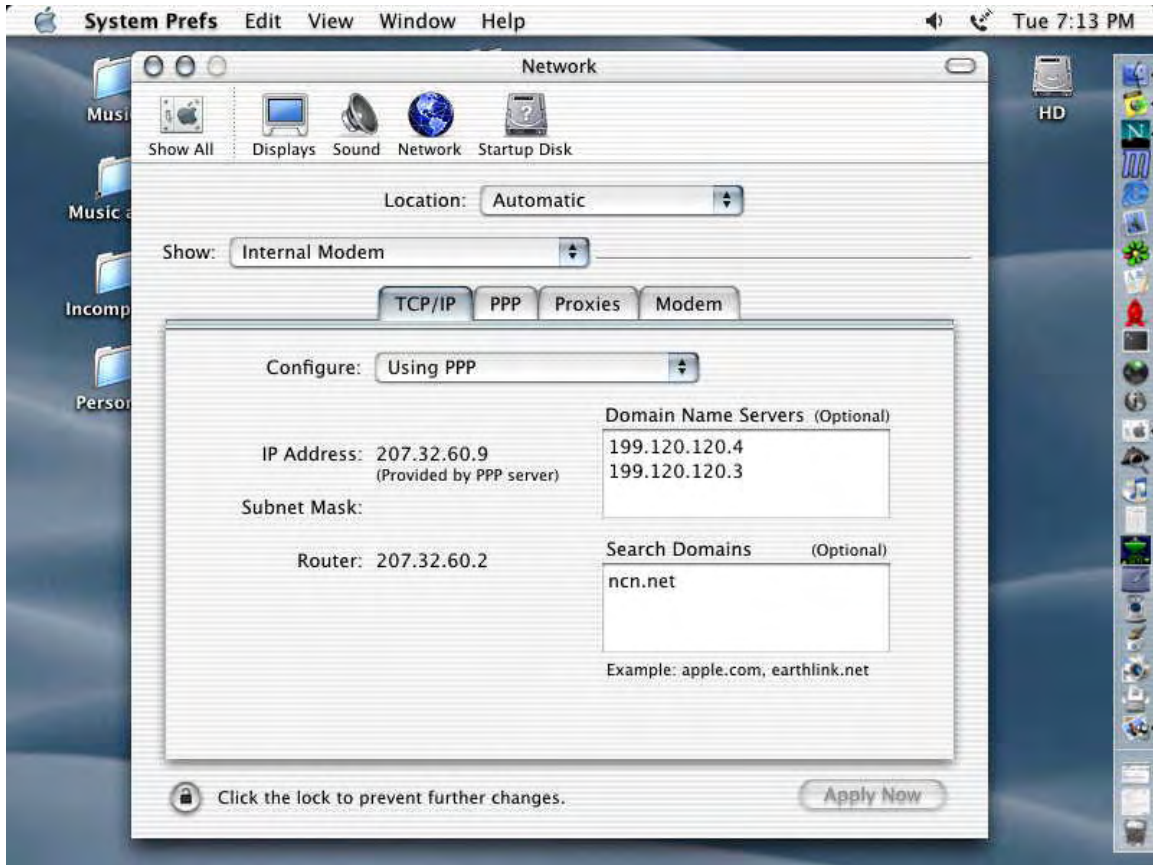


Next to Location:, select Automatic. Next to Show:, select Internal Modem. Select the TCP/IP tab.

Next to Configure:, select Using PPP. Under Domain Name Servers, type 199.120.120.4 and 199.120.120.3

Under Search Domains, type ncn.net

Click on the PPP tab.



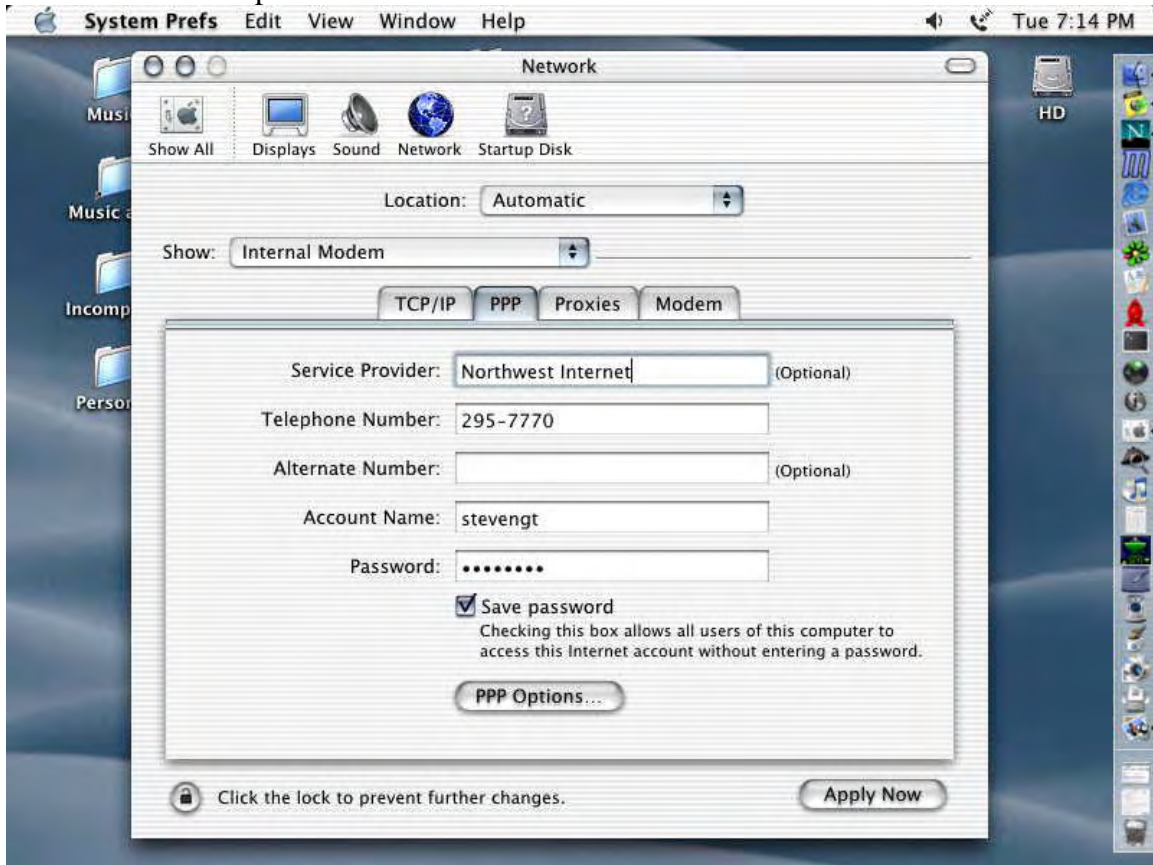
Next to Service Provider:, type Northwest Internet.

Next to Telephone Number, type the local dial up number assigned to you when you started service with Northwest.

Next to Account Name:, type the first part of your email address without the @ncn.net

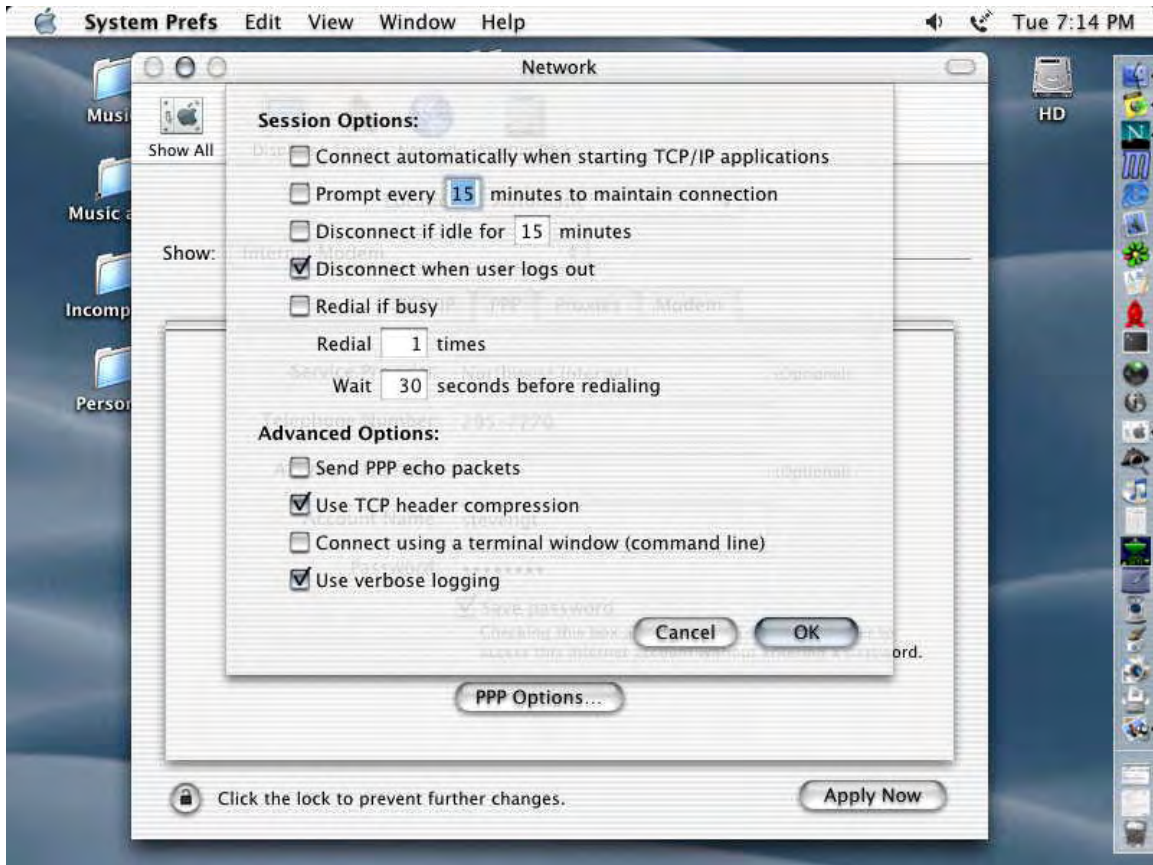
Next to Password:, type your password.

Click on the PPP Options button.



Make sure the following boxes have checks:
Connect automatically when starting TCP/IP applications
Disconnect when user logs out
Use TCP header compression

Make sure the following boxes are unchecked:
Prompt every 00 minutes to maintain connection
Disconnect if idle for 00 minutes



Click the OK button
Click the Apply Now button
